- Mothers always hold it (unless the child is adopted).
- Both parents if married to each other at the time of the child's birth.
- Both parents if married to each other at any time since the child's conception.
- Both parents if unmarried and the child was born after 2003 and the father is named on the birth certificate.
- Anyone holding a Residence Order.
- A guardian of a child.
- Adoptive parents.
- Any person who successfully applies for an Emergency Protection Order.
